Noah began his career as an honors attorney in the Office of General Counsel at the Central Intelligence Agency.

In law school, Noah clerked for the Air Force Court of Criminal Appeals and served in leadership roles on the Harvard National Security Journal. He was an active member of the Veterans Legal Clinic and was part of a team that brought two cases before the Board of Veterans' Appeals and Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims, which led the Department of Veterans Affairs to end a marriage duration requirement that unconstitutionally excluded surviving partners of LGBTQ+ veterans – expanding benefits to potentially thousands of survivors.

Before law school, Noah worked for various political campaigns and politicians, including US House Speaker Emerita Nancy Pelosi, then-Senator Kamala Harris and former Secretary of Transportation Pete Buttigieg.
