### White-collar defense

In addition to his commercial disputes practice, Bobby advises clients on internal investigations and white collar-adjacent matters, including investigations involving allegations of bribery and corruption, financial fraud, and regulatory violations. He has led investigations involving cross-border issues, conducted witness interviews, overseen on-site reviews, and advised organizations on strengthening internal controls and compliance frameworks.

Bobby maintains a strong commitment to pro bono service and has successfully represented pro bono clients in contested proceedings in state and federal courts, including matters involving domestic violence protection, access to healthcare for incarcerated individuals and criminal record expungement. Bobby was also a 2023 Leadership Council on Legal Diversity fellow and is actively involved in leadership and diversity initiatives within Cooley.

- **Lawrence Northern v. Frisk** (W.D. Wis.): Served as lead counsel in section 1983 lawsuit on behalf of Wisconsin inmate against state-employed nurse; sat first chair and delivered closing argument; tried case to verdict and won \$73,000 in compensatory damages. The trial win was highlighted in [The American Lawyer](#).
- **Pacific Gas and Electric**: Key member of team serving as court-appointed monitor of large West Coast utility in the aftermath of the 2010 San Bruno gas pipeline explosion.
- **In re Toys "R" Us, Inc.**: Serving as debtor's litigation counsel in complex reorganization of the company's finances and business operations.
- **James Doe v. Syngenta**: Defending international agricultural company Syngenta against product compliance claims.
- **Coast Products v. BP, et al.** (N.D. - **Ad Hoc Committee of Valeant Pharmaceuticals International**: Member of the team responsible for the internal investigation of Valeant Pharmaceuticals on behalf of the Ad Hoc Committee of the Valeant board of directors in response to public allegations of impropriety regarding Valeant's relationship with Philidor and various accounting issues.
