Helen was active in Hastings Moot Court as both a competitor and student coach. As a competitor, her team was regional champion and a quarterfinalist at the Thomas Tang National Moot Court Competition.

Helen is a recipient of the CALI Excellence for the Future and Witkin Top Student awards in civil procedure and received special recognition at graduation for Outstanding Achievement in Pro Bono.
